

<u>CAM700</u> pairs with <u>CAM703</u>, fitting position to cylinders 1 to 3 <u>CAM701</u> pairs with <u>CAM702</u>, fitting position to cylinders 4 to 6

How to identify between CAM702 & CAM703

Place the camshafts on a flat surface with the gear to the right, then observe the direction of the gear splines.

1. If the gear splines are in an upward direction from left to right, then the camshaft is CAM702 for fitting position to cylinders 4 to 6 : 2. If the gear splines are in an downward direction from left to right, then the camshaft is CAM703 for fitting position to cylinders 1 to 3 :
